2018 AGPA Conference Registration Fee Subsidy for Selected Graduate Students, Young Researchers and Faculty Members

Graduate students, young researchers and faculty members presenting their paper in the 2018 AGPA Conference may apply for a 50%-registration fee subsidy (limited slots only).

Eligibility requirements:

- 1) Must be a graduate student (master's or doctorate program), young researcher and/or faculty member
- 2) Must present a paper in the conference

Criteria for selection:

- 1) Quality of submitted paper, which will be evaluated based on the following criteria: relevance to conference theme, contribution to discipline, value-added quality, and clarity of language
- 2) Need of applicant (i.e., financial constraint)
- 3) Country/region of residence of applicant; priority will be given to paper presenters from low-income/developing countries

Submission Requirements:

- 1) Letter of application, showing why applicant needs the registration fee subsidy
- 2) CV of applicant
- 2)3)For partial subsidy: Powerpoint slides, for presentation in the conference
- 3)4)For full subsidy: Full paper, for possible publication in the *Philippine Journal of Public Administration* (PJPA)
